The Summer Reading Challenge is the exciting and free annual promotion of books and reading for all children, taking place in all Cheshire West and Chester Libraries. Children get a collector's pack, stickers along the way and a medal and certificate when they have read 6 books. Children love it and it's a great way to encourage them to keep their reading up over the holidays. There is a Mini Challenge for the Under 4s. It's easy to join too: just ask at your local library or join online via www.cheshirewestandchester.gov.uk/read.

This year's theme 'Ready, Set, Read!' aims to keep children's minds and bodies active over the summer break, empowering young people to forge new connections with others and unleash the power of play, sport and physical activity through reading.
