URGENT INFO FROM THE OFFICE

It is very important that arrears for any payment items are cleared before Friday 21st July as this could cause an issue with your new Arbor account. Please make sure any fees such as Caterpillar Fees, Butterfly Fees, Nursery Snack Fees, Lunch Fees, and Before & After School Club Fees are cleared on ParentPay before 21st July.
