

#### **Consultation description**

The government is committed to improving outcomes for children and young people with <u>SEND</u> and those in alternative provision.

To achieve this ambition we want to work with and hear from:

- children and young people
- parents and carers
- those who advocate and work with the <u>SEND</u> sector
- local and national system leaders

We encourage you to consider the proposals set out in this green paper and respond to our consultation.

Together, we can ensure every child and young person with <u>SEND</u> and those in alternative provision can thrive and be well prepared for adult life.

The <u>Department for Education</u> and <u>Department of Health and Social Care</u> are seeking views on our green paper about the changes we want to make to the special educational needs and disabilities (SEND) and alternative provision (AP) system in England.

The PCF has been asked to get as many views as possible from parents and young people with SEND to comment on the Government's reforms of the current SEND Legislation - SEND Review Right Support, Right Place, Right Time. **The consultation will close on July 22nd at 11.45 pm.**
