email admin@theacornsprimary.co.uk and Mrs Leadley will pick up your message over the holiday and get back to you.

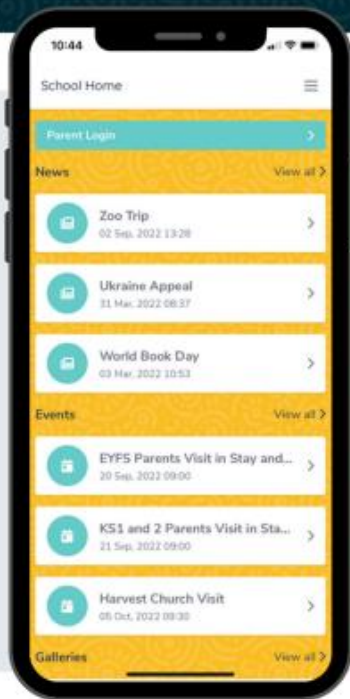
