During this term, we will be learning about trees and wildlife in our science lessons and are planning a l trip to The Wirral Way to spend the day in nature.

We will be taking all Year I children on <u>Tuesday 18th June</u> and all Year 2 children on <u>Wednesday 19th June</u>. The children will leave school after the register and walk to Overpool Train Station, where they will board the train to Hooton. Once there, they will walk over to the beginning of the trail to complete the day's activities and then head back to the station for approximately 2pm. The children will arrive back in school in time for home-time at 3.15pm. Children must all wear full uniform and will be provided with a high-vis jacket from school. They are allowed to wear trainers, if these are more comfortable than their school shoes for walking. Please also ensure your child is wearing suncream and has a sunhat – we're really hoping for some nice weather.

We are very lucky to be able to provide this trip at **no cost to parents**. Despite the rising costs of transport, we have worked hard to ensure that our pupils continue to be provided with these wonderful opportunities at no costs to you. All children are entitled to a free school lunch to take with them on the trip. This usually contains a ham or cheese sandwich, fruit, a bottle of water and another snack such as a small cake or biscuit. If you would prefer to provide your child with a packed lunch, please can you tick the box on the slip below so that we know not to order one from the kitchen. All lunches must be in a plastic or paper carrier bag so that they can be thrown away once they are finished with. Your child will also need a bottle of water to take with them and they may bring a small, healthy snack to eat during a short break we'll have before we head onto to the beach.
