- You do **NOT** have the right to take your child out of school during term time without the permission of the Headteacher.
- The school will not authorise absence during the first half of the summer term for any pupils in Year 6, even if it is exceptional, as children are sitting Standard Assessment Tests (SATs).
- Permission should be requested on the form overleaf and returned to the school office.
