Session 2 Praise and Rewards – Tuesday 12th November Promoting positive behaviours and routines with praise and rewards

Session 3 Selective Ignoring - Tuesday 19th November Reducing undesirable behaviour through selective ignoring

Session 4 Effective Instructions - Tuesday 26th November Increasing compliance with clear calm commands

Session 5 Consequences - Monday 2nd December Promoting boundaries with consequences

Session 6 Time Out and Family Rules - Tuesday 10th December Creating clear expectations with family rules and time out to calm down
